**Re: Credit Articulation Arrangements with Griffith University**

I am pleased to advise that the Dean (Learning and Teaching), Griffith Business has approved Credit Articulation arrangements between the Australian College of Community and Health Services and Griffith University as below.

For completion of the Diploma of Business (BSB50120 / 12 units):

- 80CP credit transfer awarded towards the Bachelor of Business (1632). Students can complete the Griffith degree in 160CP (2 years), commencing in Trimester 1, 2 or 3.
